

2nd Grade Supply List

1. One 1 inch “view” 3 ring binder
2. 1 pkg. skinny white board markers (Black)
3. 1 standard plastic pencil box (labeled with your child’s name) Hint: get the cheap ones for under \$2...they fit more! The cute ones don’t fit long pencils!
4. 2 white Hi-polymer erasers (they work much better than the pink erasers) 😊
5. 1 pkg. of pencil top erasers
6. 4 Elmer’s standard glue sticks (no large sizes please)
7. 1 pkg. of yellow highlighters (please purchase the pen-sized (non-gel) highlighters in yellow only!). We will use it in class often to highlight instructions.
8. 1 pkg. of Ticonderoga pencils
9. 1 wide-ruled composition notebook (labeled) – Please note: 2 notebooks for Mrs. Kendall’s class.
10. 1 small Fiskar scissors (please label)
11. 1 package of standard and pastel-colored markers (Mrs. Passage and Mrs. Gackle prefer the larger size, but Mrs. Kendall prefers the skinny markers) 😊
12. 1 box of 12 count Crayola crayons.
13. 1 pkg. of Crayola twistable colored pencils (30 count) – these are worth the money. They last longer than regular-colored pencils and don’t get chewed up by the pencil sharpener.
14. Watercolor paint set
15. 1 reliable/spill proof regular/water bottle (please label with your child’s name)
16. **1 package of baby wipes (unscented)***
17. **1 container of “Clorox” disinfecting wipes***
18. **1 box of tissues***
